CHAPTER 272

(House Bill 1190)

AN ACT concerning

Natural Resources - State Boat Act

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to use certain money to recover certain interest and penalties; authorizing the Department to establish a certain fee, not to exceed a certain amount, that the Department may charge for certain temporary certificates; extending the time period within which a licensed boat dealer shall send the Department a certain certificate; extending the expiration date for certain certificates; reducing the period of time within which certain emergency rescue boats must apply for a registration renewal; exempting altering an exemption from the requirement to pay a certain tax for the possession of certain vessels within the State for a certain time period from the requirement to pay a certain tax under certain circumstances; requiring a certain applicant to include, as part of the application, certain vessel identifying materials; defining certain terms; exempting certain fire boats from certain registration fees; exempting certain persons from the payment of the vessel excise tax on certain vessels that are held for resale or repair by certain persons in the State, under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the State Boat Act.
