Construction. In addition to that amount, the following additional funds shall be provided annually to county boards as follows:]

(F) IN FISCAL YEARS 2003 AND YEAR 2004, THE STATE SHALL DISTRIBUTE GRANTS TO COUNTY BOARDS UNDER THE AGING SCHOOLS PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS:
