1. A percentage equal to that percentage of the expenditure for basic current expenses THE FOUNDATION PROGRAM that the State pays to the petitioning jurisdiction under § 5-202(b) of this article up to a maximum of 70 percent; or

2. 50 percent.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

SECTION 7: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act reflect the terms of the consent decrees entered in the cases "Bradford, et al v. Maryland State Board of Education, et al", case no. 94340058/CE189672; "Board of School Commissioners, et al v. Maryland State Board of Education, et al", case no. 9528055/CL2002151, Baltimore City Circuit Court; and "Vaughn C., et al v. Mayor and City Council, et al", case no. MJG-84-1911, United States District Court for the District of Maryland and reflect a commitment to appropriate additional funds for the Baltimore City public schools in the following amounts: \$30 million in Fiscal Year 1998 and \$50 million in each of Fiscal Years 1999 through 2002, inclusive. [For fiscal year 2002, the Governor shall continue the commitment to appropriate \$50 million in additional funds for the Baltimore City public schools.]
