delegates to the regional association annually shall elect the student member to the Board at a special election meeting to be held each school year.

- (3) The student member may vote on all matters before the Board except those relating to:
 - (i) Capital and operating budgets;
 - (ii) School closings, reopenings, and boundaries;
 - (iii) Collective bargaining decisions;
 - (iv) Student disciplinary matters;
- (v) Teacher and administrator disciplinary matters as provided under § 6 202(a) of this article; and
 - (vi) Other personnel matters.
- (4) On an affirmative vote of a majority of the elected members of the County Board, the Board may determine if a matter before the Board relates to a subject that the student member may not vote on under paragraph (3) of this subsection.
- (5) Unless invited to attend by an affirmative vote of a majority of the County Board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to hearings on appeals of special education placements, hearings held under § 6-202(a) of this article, or collective bargaining.
- (6) The Prince George's Regional Association of Student Governments may establish procedures for the election of the student member of the County Board.
- (7) The election-procedures established by the Prince George's Regional Association of Student Governments are subject to the approval of the elected members of the County Board.
- (g) (1) An elected <u>OR APPOINTED</u> member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on the first Monday in December after the member's election <u>OR APPOINTMENT</u> and until a successor is elected and qualifies.
- (2) The terms of members are staggered as required [by the terms of the members serving on the County Board as of July 1, 1978] UNDER SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION.
- {(2)}(3) The student member serves for a term of 1 year beginning at the end of a school year.
- [(3)] (4) (1) Subject to the confirmation of the County Council, the County Executive of Prince George's County shall appoint a qualified individual to fill any vacancy on IN A POSITION OF AN ELECTED MEMBER OF the County Board until a successor is elected and qualifies at the next Congressional election.
- (II) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND THE COVERNOR SHALL FILL ANY VACANCY IN A POSITION OF AN APPOINTED
