AN ACT concerning

**Motor Vehicle Administration - Drivers' Licenses and Identification Cards -
Selective Service Administration Registration**

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide to the Selective Service Administration certain information concerning male applicants of a certain age who apply for a driver's license or identification card under certain circumstances; establishing that a signature on an application for a driver's license or identification card ~~constitutes consent to~~ indicates that the applicant has selected one of the options on the application form concerning the forwarding of certain information to the Selective Service Administration; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide certain information on a certain application; ~~providing that an applicant's refusal to consent to certain information being sent to the Selective Service Administration does not constitute grounds for denial of a driver's license or identification card;~~ providing that an applicant's refusal to consent to certain information being sent to the Selective Service Administration does not constitute grounds for denial of a driver's license or identification card; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to forward certain information to the Selective Service Administration in a certain manner; making certain provisions of this Act contingent on certain federal funding; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administrator to take certain actions regarding federal funding to implement certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to drivers' licenses and identification cards.
