SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

18-113.

(A) ~~EXCEPT FOR THE GUARANTEED ACCESS GRANT AWARDED UNDER § 18-301 OF THIS TITLE, A STUDENT MAY HOLD A SCHOLARSHIP, SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT, OR LOAN ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE ALONG WITH ANY OTHER SCHOLARSHIP, SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT, OR LOAN ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE IF:~~

(1) ~~ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS ARE MET FOR EACH SCHOLARSHIP, SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT, OR LOAN RECEIVED; AND~~

(2) ~~THE TOTAL OF ALL SCHOLARSHIPS, SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS, OR LOANS RECEIVED DOES NOT EXCEED:~~

(I) ~~THE STUDENT'S TOTAL COST OF EDUCATION AS CERTIFIED BY THE INSTITUTION THE STUDENT IS ATTENDING; AND~~

(II) ~~THE EQUIVALENT ANNUAL EXPENSE EXPENSES OF A FULL-TIME RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND COLLEGE PARK 4-YEAR PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION WITHIN THE~~
