

(1) Complete a performance evaluation of the College Readiness Outreach Program that shall evaluate both the outcomes and the effectiveness of the Program; and

(2) Report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the performance evaluation and any recommendations for increasing the effectiveness of the Program.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Governor include \$3 million in the State budget in fiscal 2002 to implement Education Excellence Awards to be made by institutions of higher education in the State established under § 18-307(d) of the Education Article.~~

SECTION ~~10.~~ 5. ~~6.~~ AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any reference in the Annotated Code rendered obsolete by this Act shall be corrected by the publisher of the Annotated Code, in consultation with and subject to the approval of the Department of Legislative Services, with no further action required by the General Assembly. The publisher of the Annotated Code shall adequately describe any such correction in an editor's note following the section affected.
