~~SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the State Board of Stationary Engineers shall expire as follows:~~

~~SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on July 1, 2003, all the functions, powers, duties, equipment, assets, liabilities, records, and employees of the Board of Examining Engineers shall be transferred to the State Board of Stationary Engineers.~~

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an individual who holds a license issued by the Board of Examining Engineers on July 1, 2003 may qualify for the same grade license issued by the State Board of Stationary Engineers without meeting the education, experience, and examination requirements of Title 6.5, Subtitle 3 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article if the individual qualifies for the license before the expiration of the individual's license.~~

~~SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an individual who holds a license issued by the Board of Examining Engineers on July 1, 2003, in all respects, shall be considered licensed by the State Board of Stationary Engineers and, subject to the provisions of this Act, for the remainder of the term of the individual's license. On expiration of the individual's license, the individual may qualify for renewal of a license under § 6.5-311 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article as if the individual has held a license issued by the Board of Examining Engineers.~~
