CHAPTER 335

(Senate Bill 733)

AN ACT concerning

Crimes - Railroad Trespass

FOR the purpose of repealing a prohibition against a person being in or on a certain railroad vehicle under certain circumstances; repealing a certain penalty; prohibiting entering or remaining on railroad property except under certain circumstances; prohibiting riding on certain railroad equipment vehicles without consent or other lawful authorization; establishing criminal penalties for violations of this Act; providing certain exceptions; defining certain terms; and generally relating to railroad trespass.
