 - 1. GIVEN WITH THE CONSENT OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT;

- 2. RECOGNIZED BY STATE LAW IN PLACE OF MEDICAL
- (8) (I) "SEXUAL ABUSE" MEANS AN ACT THAT INVOLVES SEXUAL MOLESTATION OR EXPLOITATION OF A VULNERABLE ADULT.
 - (II) "SEXUAL ABUSE" INCLUDES:
 - INCEST;
 - 2. RAPE:
 - 3. SEXUAL OFFENSE IN ANY DEGREE;
 - 4. SODOMY: AND
 - 5. UNNATURAL OR PERVERTED SEXUAL PRACTICES.
- (9) "VULNERABLE ADULT" MEANS AN ADULT WHO LACKS THE PHYSICAL OR MENTAL CAPACITY TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADULT'S DAILY NEEDS.
 - (B) PROHIBITED.
- (1) A CAREGIVER, A PARENT, OR OTHER PERSON WHO HAS PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY CARE OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SUPERVISION OF A VULNERABLE ADULT MAY NOT CAUSE ABUSE OR NEGLECT OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT.
- (2) A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OR FAMILY MEMBER MAY NOT CAUSE ABUSE OR NEGLECT OF A VULNERABLE ADULT.
 - (C) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.
