

(VI) THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

(B) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR DUTIES PERFORMED AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR INITIAL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE APPOINTED MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(5) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE AN APPOINTED MEMBER FOR NEGLIGENCE OF DUTY, INCOMPETENCE, OR MISCONDUCT.

(D) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, WHEN APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ASSURE GEOGRAPHIC BALANCE AND PROMOTE RACIAL AND GENDER DIVERSITY IN THE COUNCIL'S MEMBERSHIP.

(A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL WHO SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR.
