(VI) THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

- (B) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:
- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR DUTIES PERFORMED AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
 - (C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR INITIAL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

- (4) (5) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE AN APPOINTED MEMBER FOR NEGLECT OF DUTY, INCOMPETENCE, OR MISCONDUCT.
- (D) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, WHEN APPOINTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ASSURE GEOGRAPHIC BALANCE AND PROMOTE RACIAL AND GENDER DIVERSITY IN THE COUNCIL'S MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL WHO SHALL SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR.
 - (B) (1) THE COVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A DIRECTOR OF THE COUNCIL.
- (2) THE DIRECTOR IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (3) UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE COUNCIL, THE DIRECTOR SHALL PERFORM ANY DUTY OR FUNCTION THAT THE COUNCIL REQUIRES.
- (C) THE COUNCIL SHALL EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET AND SUPPLEMENTED, AS NECESSARY, WITH STAFF FROM THE APPROPRIATE STATE ACENCIES.

- (A) THE COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT LEAST FOUR TIMES A YEAR OR AT THE DIRECTION OF THE CHAIRMAN.
