

(C) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT AN INTERNSHIP PROGRAM TO PERMIT THE PRACTICE OF RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGY, MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGY, OR NUCLEAR MEDICINE TECHNOLOGY BY AN INDIVIDUAL WITHOUT A CERTIFICATE WHO HAS NOT MET THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT IF THE INDIVIDUALS MEET ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND IS WAITING FOR:

(1) THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE THE ~~FIRST~~ EXAMINATION ~~AVAILABLE~~ WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER GRADUATION FROM AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD; OR

(2) THE RESULTS OF THE ~~FIRST~~ EXAMINATION TAKEN WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER GRADUATION FROM AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

(D) EXCEPT FOR REQUIREMENTS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD FOR CERTIFICATE RENEWAL UNDER § 14-5B-10 OF THIS SUBTITLE, NOTHING IN THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD AS A RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGIST, MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGIST, OR NUCLEAR MEDICINE TECHNOLOGIST AS OF JULY 1, 2001 TO MEET ADDITIONAL EDUCATION, TRAINING, OR EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO REMAIN CERTIFIED.

(A) TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND

(2) PAY TO THE BOARD THE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE THE APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATE TO AN APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR THAT CERTIFICATE.

(C) CERTIFICATION AS A RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGIST AUTHORIZES AN INDIVIDUAL TO PRACTICE RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGY WHILE THE CERTIFICATE IS EFFECTIVE.
