- (C) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT AN INTERNSHIP PROGRAM TO PERMIT THE PRACTICE OF <u>RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGY</u>, MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGY, OR NUCLEAR MEDICINE TECHNOLOGY BY AN INDIVIDUAL WITHOUT A CERTIFICATE WHO HAS NOT MET THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT IF THE INDIVIDUALS MEET ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND IS WAITING FOR:
- (1) THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE THE FIRST EXAMINATION AVAILABLE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER GRADUATION FROM AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD; OR
- (2) THE RESULTS OF THE FIRST EXAMINATION TAKEN WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER GRADUATION FROM AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM APPROVED BY THE BOARD.
- (D) EXCEPT FOR REQUIREMENTS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD FOR CERTIFICATE RENEWAL UNDER § 14–5B–10 OF THIS SUBTITLE, NOTHING IN THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CERTIFIED BY THE BOARD AS A RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGIST, MEDICAL RADIATION TECHNOLOGIST, OR NUCLEAR MEDICINE TECHNOLOGIST AS OF JULY 1, 2001 TO MEET ADDITIONAL EDUCATION, TRAINING, OR EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO REMAIN CERTIFIED.

- (C) CERTIFICATION AS A RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGIST AUTHORIZES AN INDIVIDUAL TO PRACTICE RADIATION ONCOLOGY/THERAPY TECHNOLOGY WHILE THE CERTIFICATE IS EFFECTIVE.
