

(4) § 10-207(c-1) of this title (State tax exempt interest from mutual funds)[; or

(5) § 10-207(u) of this title (Amounts received by Stadium Authority affiliate in consideration of transfer of certified rehabilitation credit)].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Maryland Heritage Structure Rehabilitation Tax Credit under Article 83B, § 5-801 of the Code may not be claimed with respect to the construction or development of any structure located on the Hippodrome Performing Arts Center site, as defined in § 13-701 of the Financial Institutions Article.

SECTION 2.3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2002.

## CHAPTER 418

(House Bill 1272)

AN ACT concerning

### **Criminal Justice Information System - Criminal History Records Checks**

FOR the purpose of specifying certain procedures and fees to obtain criminal history records checks for individuals applying for certain permits and licenses including handgun permits, regulated firearms dealers, private detectives, security guard agencies, and security guards, as well as certain employees, licensees, and other persons under the jurisdiction of the Maryland Racing Commission; defining certain terms; and generally relating to criminal history records checks.
