SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Administrative Office of the Courts:

(a) shall review the compensation of District Court bailiffs and evaluate the appropriateness of their compensation in comparison to the compensation of other court courts' security personnel, ~~including bailiffs in the circuit courts;~~ and

(b) on or before December 15, 2002, shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on its findings and recommendations.

~~SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of § 2-609 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall apply to all bailiffs employed by the District Court on or after the effective date of this Act.~~

SECTION 4. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
