IN MAKING A DETERMINATION UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION WITH RESPECT TO A PETITIONER, THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSIDER:

- (1) THE EFFECT OF THE DETERMINATION ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE PETITIONER;
 - (2) THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE;
 - (3) THE SAFETY OF THE PETITIONER;
- (4) ANY OTHER VALID REASON FOR THE PETITIONER TO PURCHASE, POSSESS, OR USE BULLETPROOF BODY ARMOR; AND
 - (5) THE TOTALITY OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES.
 - (E) SAME CONDITIONS.

AS A CONDITION OF ISSUING A PERMIT TO A PETITIONER, THE SECRETARY SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE PETITIONER AGREE TO MAINTAIN IN THE PERSON'S POSSESSION A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE PERMIT, INCLUDING ANY TERMS, CONDITIONS, OR LIMITATIONS.

- (F) SAME DURATION AND RENEWAL.
- (1) A PERMIT UNDER THIS SECTION EXPIRES 5 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF ITS ISSUANCE.
- (2) A PERMIT SHALL BE RENEWED FOR SUCCESSIVE PERIODS OF 5 YEARS IF THE APPLICANT:
- (I) FILES AN APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL AT ANY TIME WITHIN 3 MONTHS BEFORE THE PERMIT EXPIRES; AND
 - (II) SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
 - (G) SAME REVOCATION.

THE SECRETARY MAY REVOKE A PERMIT AT ANY TIME IF THE SECRETARY FINDS THAT THE HOLDER NO LONGER SATISFIES THE QUALIFICATIONS SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.

(H) INFORMAL REVIEW.

- (1) A PERSON WHOSE APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT OR RENEWAL OF A PERMIT HAS BEEN REJECTED OR WHOSE PERMIT HAS BEEN REVOKED OR LIMITED MAY REQUEST THE SECRETARY TO CONDUCT AN INFORMAL REVIEW BY FILING A WRITTEN REQUEST WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE SECRETARYS INITIAL ACTION.
- (2) THE INFORMAL REVIEW MAY INCLUDE A PERSONAL INTERVIEW OF THE APPLICANT.
- (3) AN INFORMAL REVIEW UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
