- (A) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY ORDER, RULE, OR REGULATION ISSUED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING $\frac{1}{2}$ YEAR $\frac{6}{2}$ MONTHS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.

- (a) The Adjutant General shall:
- (1) Be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Senate;
- (2) Have a commissioned grade not above that of Lieutenant General; [and]

- (4) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THE GOVERNOR'S POLICIES WITH RESPECT TO THOSE MATTERS SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE AND ARTICLE 16A OF THE CODE.

Article 88B - Department of State Police

(a) The affairs and operations of the Department shall be supervised and directed by a Secretary. The Secretary shall report to the Governor AND BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THE GOVERNOR'S POLICIES WITH RESPECT TO THOSE MATTERS SPECIFIED IN THIS ARTICLE AND ARTICLE 16A OF THE CODE.

(b) (1) The Secretary serves at the pleasure of the Governor and is responsible directly to the Governor. The Secretary shall advise the Governor on all matters assigned to the Department and is responsible for carrying out the Governor's policies on these matters.
