- $\underline{\text{(VI)}}$  ONE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER, OR THE LOCAL HEALTH OFFICER'S DESIGNEE.
  - (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE TASK FORCE.
  - (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE TASK FORCE.
- $\underline{\text{(E)}}$  A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE TASK FORCE IS A QUORUM.
  - (F) THE TASK FORCE SHALL CONDUCT A NEEDS ASSESSMENT TO IDENTIFY:
- (1) AVAILABLE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS AND PROGRAMS CONCERNING OSTEOPOROSIS NATIONWIDE;
- (2) THE LEVEL OF PUBLIC AND PROFESSIONAL AWARENESS ABOUT OSTEOPOROSIS;
- (3) THE NEEDS OF OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS, AND THE FAMILIES AND CAREGIVERS OF OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS;
- (4) THE NEEDS OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, INCLUDING PHYSICIANS, NURSES, AND MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS, THAT PROVIDE SERVICES TO OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS;
  - (5) THE SERVICES AVAILABLE TO OSTEOPOROSIS PATIENTS;
- (6) THE EXISTENCE OF OSTEOPOROSIS TREATMENT GROUPS, SUPPORT GROUPS, AND REHABILITATION SERVICES; AND
- (7) THE AMOUNT AND LOCATION OF BONE DENSITY TESTING EQUIPMENT.
- (G) THE TASK FORCE SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT ABOUT:
- (1) ANY LEGISLATION OR REGULATION THAT MAY BE NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE TO IMPLEMENT THIS SUBTITLE;

IN ESTABLISHING THE PROGRAM REQUIRED BY § 13–1603 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
