SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Finance and Procurement

3-401.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, except as provided in subsection (a) of this section and [§ 3-403(c)] §§ 3-403(C), 3-405(A)(2), 3-410.1, AND 3-410.2 of this subtitle, this subtitle applies to all units of the Executive Branch of State government including public institutions of higher education other than the University System of Maryland.

3-402.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) “Board” means the Information Technology Board.
- (c) “Chief” means the Chief of Information Technology.

(D) (1) “DEVELOPMENT” MEANS ALL EXPENDITURES FOR A NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SYSTEM OR AN ENHANCEMENT TO AN EXISTING SYSTEM INCLUDING SYSTEM:

- (I) PLANNING;
- (II) PROCUREMENT;
- (III) CREATION;
- (IV) INSTALLATION;
- (V) TESTING; AND
- (VI) INITIAL TRAINING.

(2) “DEVELOPMENT” DOES NOT INCLUDE:

(I) ONGOING OPERATING COSTS, SOFTWARE OR HARDWARE MAINTENANCE, ROUTINE UPGRADES, OR; MODIFICATIONS THAT MERELY ALLOW FOR A CONTINUATION OF THE EXISTING LEVEL OF FUNCTIONALITY; OR

(II) EXPENDITURES MADE AFTER A NEW OR ENHANCED SYSTEM HAS BEEN LEGALLY ACCEPTED BY THE USER AND IS BEING USED FOR THE BUSINESS PROCESS FOR WHICH IT WAS INTENDED.
