

(C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO SUPPORT MAJOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

(D) THE FUND IS A CONTINUING, NONLAPSING SPECIAL FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(E) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

(1) ALL MONEYS APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;

(2) MONEYS RECEIVED FROM THE SALE, LEASE, OR EXCHANGE OF COMMUNICATION SITES OR COMMUNICATION FREQUENCIES FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PURPOSES AS DETERMINED BY THE CHIEF AND AS APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY;

(3) MONEYS RECEIVED AS COMMISSIONS, REBATES, REFUNDS, RATE REDUCTIONS, OR TELECOMMUNICATION BYPASS AGREEMENTS RESULTING FROM INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES OR PURCHASES;

(4) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, THAT PORTION OF MONEYS EARNED FROM PAY PHONE COMMISSIONS TO THE EXTENT THAT THE COMMISSION RATES EXCEED THOSE IN EFFECT IN DECEMBER 1993; ~~AND~~

(5) ANY MONEYS RECEIVED AND ACCEPTED AS GIFTS, CONTRIBUTIONS, OR GRANTS AS AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION; ~~AND~~

(6) GENERAL FUNDS APPROPRIATED FOR MAJOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS OF ANY UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT OTHER THAN A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT:

(I) ARE UNENCUMBERED AND UNEXPENDED AT THE END OF A FISCAL YEAR;

(II) HAVE BEEN ABANDONED; OR

(III) HAVE BEEN WITHHELD BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR THE SECRETARY.

(F) THE FUND DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY MONEYS:

(1) RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, OR MARYLAND PUBLIC BROADCASTING COMMISSION;

(2) RECEIVED BY THE JUDICIAL OR LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF STATE GOVERNMENT; OR

(3) GENERATED FROM PAY PHONE COMMISSIONS THAT ARE CREDITED TO OTHER ACCOUNTS OR FUNDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF LAW OR ARE AUTHORIZED FOR OTHER PURPOSES IN THE BUDGET OR THROUGH AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.

(G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD AND THE STATE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
