(BB) SCHEDULE V.

"SCHEDULE V" MEANS A LIST OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES THAT APPEARS IN § 5-406 OF THIS TITLE.

(CC) SECRETARY.

"SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to allow concise reference to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

(DD) ULTIMATE USER.

"ULTIMATE USER" MEANS A PERSON WHO LAWFULLY POSSESSES A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE FOR THE PERSON'S OWN USE, FOR THE USE OF A MEMBER OF THE PERSON'S HOUSEHOLD, OR FOR ADMINISTRATION TO AN ANIMAL OWNED BY THE PERSON OR BY A MEMBER OF THE PERSON'S HOUSEHOLD.

REVISOR'S NOTE TO SECTION

Former Art. 27, § 277(d), which defined "Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs" as the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs of the United States Department of Justice, is deleted as obsolete. In 1973, the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs was abolished by Executive Order, and its functions were taken over by the federal Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), which is unnecessary to define in this title. See §§ 3 and 4 of Reorganization Plan No. 2 of 1973 in U.S.C. Title 5, Appendix 1.

Former Art. 27, § 277(w), which defined "State" as the "State of Maryland", is deleted as an unnecessary statement of a standard rule of statutory
