(Senate Bill 580)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Docking Masters

FOR the purpose of ~~altering the membership of the State Board of Docking Masters;~~ establishing a trainee docking master program; authorizing the Board to issue certain limited docking master licenses; establishing certain limited license qualifications and fees; altering the ~~hearing~~ provisions for certain disciplinary actions by the Board; authorizing the Board to impose certain civil penalties; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the State Board of Docking Masters.
