- (1) to maneuver a vessel during berthing or unberthing operations with tug assistance; or
 - (2) to shift a vessel within a port, with tug assistance.

- (a) (1) The Board consists of [5] 7 members.
 - (2) Of the [5] 7 members of the Board:
 - (i) 1 SHALL BE THE PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION:
 - (II) 2 shall be-licensed decking masters;

[(ii)] (III) 1 shall be a representative of a towing boat company serving the Port of Baltimore; [and]

(IV) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE STEAMSHIP INDUSTRY SERVING THE PORT OF BALTIMORE ACTIVELY EMPLOYING DOCKING MASTERS: AND

[(iii)] (V) 2 shall be consumer members.

(3) The Governor shall appoint each member UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II), (III), (IV), AND (V) with the advice of the Sceretary and the advice and consent of the Scenate.

SUBTITLE 3. TRAINEE DOCKING MASTERS.

5.5 - 301.

AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE BOARD BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY SERVE AS A TRAINEE DOCKING MASTER.

5.5 - 302.

THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A LIST OF ALL APPLICANTS WHO QUALIFY TO BE TRAINEE DOCKING MASTERS.

5.5 - 303.

TO BE INCLUDED ON THE LIST OF APPLICANTS WHO QUALIFY TO BE TRAINEE DOCKING MASTERS, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

- (1) BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD;
- (2) BE A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES;
