

to a certain date the termination provisions relating to statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring the Board to pay certain moneys into the General Fund of the State; providing that compensation of the Board and reimbursement for expenses shall be as provided in the State budget; making provisions of law that apply to certain inactive pilots apply to certain permanently disabled pilots; repealing provisions of law that refer to permanently disabled pilots as an independent category of pilot; requiring the Association of Maryland Pilots to distribute certain payments to inactive pilots on behalf of the Board; altering a provision that requires the Board to make certain payments; ~~requiring the Association to consider certain tax implications when making certain payments~~; altering the oversight of the Maintenance and Replacement Fund by requiring the Association to maintain the Fund instead of the Board; requiring the Association to obtain written approval from the Board for certain expenditures; requiring the Association to maintain a certain fund balance; providing a certain exception to the requirement to maintain a certain fund balance; requiring the Association to submit to the Board certain financial audits of certain payments; requiring the Board to maintain copies of financial audits; requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to them be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the Board to report to certain committees on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board of Pilots.
