- (3) The Registration Fund shall be used to cover the actual documented direct and indirect costs incurred for the administration and enforcement of the Maryland Home Builder Registration Act.
- (4) The Registration Fund is a continuing, nonlapsing fund, and is subject to § 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- (5) Unspent assets of the Registration Fund shall remain in the Registration Fund and may not revert or be transferred to the General Fund of the State.
- (6) The Registration Fund may not be supported by appropriations of State funds.
- (b) (1) [By regulation, the Division shall establish reasonable fees that may not exceed \$600 over a 2 year period, and a fee schedule for the issuance and renewal of registrations.] THE DIVISION SHALL COLLECT A BIENNIAL REGISTRATION FEE FROM EACH PERSON REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (2) THE RECISTRATION FEE SHALL BE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF NEW HOMES CONSTRUCTED BY THE PERSON IN THE CALENDAR YEAR PRECEDING THE 2 YEAR REGISTRATION PERIOD AS FOLLOWS:
  - (I) 10 OR FEWER NEW HOMES \$200
  - (II) 11 OR MORE NEW HOMES \$600
- (3) The fees charged shall approximate the direct and indirect costs of administering and enforcing the Maryland Home Builder Registration Act.
- (e) The Division shall pay all funds collected under \$-4.5-303 §§ 4.5-303, 4.5-304, AND 4.5-305 of this title to the Comptroller, who shall distribute the fees to the Registration Fund.
- (d) (C) The Office of Legislative Audits shall audit the accounts and transactions of the Registration Fund under § 2–1220 of the State Government Article.

## 4.5–304.

- (a) The Unit shall register and issue a home builder registration number to an applicant that:
  - (1) meets the requirements of this title[.]; AND
- (2) PAYS TO THE DIVISION AN INITIAL 2-YEAR REGISTRATION FEE OF \$600.
- (b) A registration issued under this title may not be transferred, assigned, or pledged.
- $\underline{\text{(c)}}$  A valid registration authorizes the registrant to act as a home builder in the State.
