IF THE OBLIGOR HAS MORE THAN ONE CHILD SUPPORT CASE WITH ARREARS, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT RECEIVED AMONG ONE OR MORE OF THE OBLIGOR'S CASES, AS DETERMINED APPROPRIATE BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
- $rac{(H)}{G}$ (1) AN OBLIGOR OR AN ACCOUNT HOLDER OF INTEREST MAY CHALLENGE THE ACTIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER THIS SECTION BY:
- (I) FILING A REQUEST FOR AN INVESTIGATION WITH THE ADMINISTRATION; OR
 - (II) FILING A MOTION WITH THE CIRCUIT COURT.
- (2) A CHALLENGE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL:
 - (I) BE IN WRITING;
- (II) BE RECEIVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION OR, IF THERE IS AN ACCOUNT HOLDER OF INTEREST OTHER THAN THE OBLIGOR, WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE NOTICE UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION;
- (III) BE SENT TO THE CONTACT PERSON IDENTIFIED IN THE NOTICE SENT TO THE OBLIGOR UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION; AND
 - (IV) SPECIFY, IN DETAIL, THE REASONS FOR THE CHALLENGE.
- (3) AN OBLIGOR OR ACCOUNT HOLDER OF INTEREST MAY NOT CHALLENGE THE ACTIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATION ON ISSUES RELATED TO VISITATION, CUSTODY, OR OTHER MATTERS NOT RELATED TO AN ACCOUNT.
