

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a)(1) and (b) through (f) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 279(b).

Subsection (a)(2) and (3) of this section is new language added to state explicitly that which was only formerly implied in the law.

In subsection (e) of this section, the reference to being excepted "under this subtitle" is added for clarity.

In subsection (f)(1) and (3) of this section, the reference to abuse "of the substance" is added for clarity. Similarly, in subsection (f)(2) of this section, the reference to use "of the substance" is added for clarity.

In subsection (f)(3) of this section, the reference to "evidence that" abuse of the substance may lead to dependence is added for clarity.

Also in subsection (f)(3) of this section, the reference to "psychological" dependence is substituted for the former reference to "psychic" dependence for clarity.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SCHEDULE III CONSISTS OF EACH CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE:

(1) LISTED IN THIS SECTION;

(2) ADDED TO SCHEDULE III BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER § 5-202(B) OF THIS TITLE; OR

(3) DESIGNATED AS A SCHEDULE III CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT OBJECTS UNDER § 5-202(F) OF THIS TITLE.

(B) NALORPHINE AND ANABOLIC STEROID.

(1) SUBSTANCES LISTED IN SCHEDULE III INCLUDE:

(I) NALORPHINE; AND

(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN ANABOLIC STEROID CONSISTING OF A MATERIAL, COMPOUND, OR PREPARATION THAT INCLUDES:

1. BOLDENONE;
