CHAPTER 542

(House Bill 774)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Park Police - Expansion

PG/MC 109-02

FOR the purpose of creating a certain exception to the prohibition against construing a certain provision of State law to allow the expansion of park police forces of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission beyond a certain limit; making the exception apply to a ~~local law enacted in~~ mutual aid agreement approved by Prince George's County or ~~in~~ by Montgomery County; clarifying that this Act applies to the expansion of Commission police forces in Prince George's County, Montgomery County, or both counties; and generally relating to the park police forces of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission
5-114.**

(a) The Commission may appoint whatever park police officers as may be necessary to provide protection for the Commission's activities and property. In connection with the responsibility to provide that protection, it is the responsibility of the park police to prevent crime, apprehend criminals, enforce the criminal and motor vehicle laws of the State, enforce park regulations and perform whatever other related duties as are imposed by the Commission.
