- (j) (1) In this subsection, "imprisonment" includes confinement <u>MEANS</u> <u>INCLUDES CONFINEMENT IN:</u>
- $\underline{\text{CONFINEMENT}}$ in an \underline{AN} inpatient rehabilitation or treatment center; \underline{OR}
- (II) HOME DETENTION ON THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT CONSTITUTE RESIDENTIAL CONFINEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN A DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT PROGRAM CERTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE THAT INCLUDES ELECTRONIC MONITORING.
