SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

8-507.1.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CAROLINE COUNTY.
- · (B) THERE IS A CLASS GC 7-DAY (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- (C) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A GOLF COURSE OR ORGANIZATION THAT:
 - (1) IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC;
 - (2) IS OPERATED FOR PROFIT;
 - (3) OWNS REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY; AND
 - (4) HAS A GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF 18 HOLES.
 - (D) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,600.
