In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 846 – Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Inspector's Salary.

This bill increases the salary of the alcoholic beverages inspector in Frederick County from \$32,000 to \$35,000.

House Bill 435, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 846.

**Frederick County – Alcoholic Beverages – Inspector's Salary**
