 - (B) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE MARYLAND SECURITY COUNCIL.
- (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND SECURITY COUNCIL.
 - (D) "EMERGENCY" MEANS:
- (1) THE THREAT OR OCCURRENCE OF ANY HURRICANE, TORNADO, STORM, FLOOD, HIGH WATER, WIND-DRIVEN WATER, TIDAL WAVE, EARTHQUAKE, LANDSLIDE, MUDSLIDE, SNOWSTORM, DROUGHT, FIRE, EXPLOSION, OR OTHER CATASTROPHE IN ANY PART OF THE STATE WHICH REQUIRES STATE EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE TO SUPPLEMENT LOCAL EFFORTS IN ORDER TO SAVE LIVES AND PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE; OR
- (2) THE THREAT OR OCCURRENCE OF ANY ENEMY ATTACK, ACT OF TERRORISM, OR PUBLIC HEALTH CATASTROPHE.
- (E) (D) (1) "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT" MEANS A PERMANENT INSTRUMENTALITY IN THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, OR JUDICIAL BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.
- (2) "GOVERNMENTAL UNIT" INCLUDES A DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, AGENCY, OR SUBUNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE, OR JUDICIAL BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.
