SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

6 - 305.

An applicant for a State license shall:

- (1) submit to the State Board an application on the form that the State Board provides; [and]
- (2) pay to the State Board or the State Board's designee an examination fee set by the Board in an amount not to exceed the cost of the required examination;
- (3) REPORT TO THE STATE BOARD THE NUMBER AND JURISDICTION OF ALL OTHER MASTER ELECTRICIAN LICENSES HELD BY THE APPLICANT.

- (e) Before a State license expires, the State licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2 year term, if the State licensee:
 - (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
 - (2) pays to the State Board a renewal fee of \$25; [and]
- (3) submits to the State Board a renewal application on the form that the State Board provides; AND
- (4) REPORTS TO THE STATE BOARD THE NUMBER AND JURISDICTION OF ALL OTHER MASTER ELECTRICIAN LICENSES HELD BY THE LICENSEE.
