VETOES

- (I) CREATES A SUBSTANTIAL RISK OF DEATH; OR
- (II) CAUSES PERMANENT OR PROTRACTED SERIOUS:
 - 1. DISFIGUREMENT;
 - 2. LOSS OF THE FUNCTION OF ANY BODILY MEMBER OR

ORGAN: OR

3. IMPAIRMENT OF THE FUNCTION OF ANY BODILY MEMBER

OR ORGAN.

- [(8)](9) (i) "Sexual abuse" means an act that involves sexual molestation or exploitation of a vulnerable adult.
 - (ii) "Sexual abuse" includes:
 - 1. incest;
 - 2. rape;
 - 3. sexual offense in any degree;
 - 4. sodomy; and
 - 5. unnatural or perverted sexual practices.
- [(9)](10) "Vulnerable adult" means an adult who lacks the physical or mental capacity to provide for the adult's daily needs.
- (b) (1) A caregiver, a parent, or other person who has permanent or temporary care or responsibility for the supervision of a vulnerable adult may not cause abuse or neglect of the vulnerable adult THAT:
 - (I) RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT;
- (II) CAUSES SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO THE VULNERABLE ADULT; OR
 - (III) INVOLVES SEXUAL ABUSE OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT.
- (2) A household member or family member may not cause abuse or neglect of a vulnerable adult THAT:
 - (I) RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT;
- (II) CAUSES SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY TO THE VULNERABLE ADULT; OR
 - (III) INVOLVES SEXUAL ABUSE OF THE VULNERABLE ADULT.
- (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of [a misdemeanor] THE FELONY OF ABUSE OR NEGLECT OF A VULNERABLE ADULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [5] 15 10 years or a fine not exceeding [\$5,000] \$15,000 \$10,000 or both.
