AN ACT concerning

Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership

FOR the purpose of ~~adding a representative from the Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission~~ amending the membership of the Maryland Veterans Commission; and generally relating to the membership of the Maryland Veterans Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-907.

(a) (1) The Commission consists of the following ~~{29}~~ ~~29~~ members:

(i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission; and

(ii) ~~{28}~~ ~~29~~ members appointed by the Governor.

(2) Of the ~~{28}~~ ~~29~~ appointed members:

(i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in the State;

(ii) 1 shall be a veteran of World War II, appointed from the State at large;

(iii) 1 shall be a representative of a women veterans organization in the State; ~~and~~

(iv) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to the Governor by each of the following organizations:

1. the American Ex-Prisoners of War, Inc.;

2. the American Legion;
