Resolution No: 2002-06**

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 714 of the Charter of the Town of Kensington has limitations of content that hinder the ability of the Town to carry out its mandated functions;

WHEREAS, the Charter amendment to Article VII, Section 714 has been developed by the Council to improve the governance of the Town;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 714 is amended to fill a vacancy in the office of Mayor the same way as a vacancy of the Council, by special election if the vacancy occurs ninety days or more prior to the end of the term;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 910 of the Charter of the Town of Kensington has limitations of content that hinder the ability of the Town to carry out its mandated functions;

WHEREAS, the Charter amendment to Article IX, Section 910 has been developed by the Council to improve the governance of the Town;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 910 is deleted in its entirety [“The Mayor, with the approval of the Council, may appoint a health officer, who shall be a licensed physician who shall safeguard the health of the Town and who may make recommendations to the Mayor and Council on health issues.”];
