Bill No. 01-30

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 4-5, Council districts, of Article I, Legislative Branch, of Chapter 4, Administration of Government, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to establish new Council districts in lieu of the plan presented by the Redistricting Commission; to list the election precincts of which each Council district is comprised, to show generally the boundary lines of each Council district; and generally relating to Council districts.

Bill No. 01-33 (As Amended)

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Chapter 214, Sediment Control and Stormwater Management, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for compliance with new state requirements regarding sediment control and stormwater quantity and quality management.

Bill No. 01-35 (As Amended)

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection 267-41.1, Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay District, of Article VI, District Regulations, of Part 1, Standards, of Chapter 267, Zoning, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to address the state-mandated Comprehensive Review of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program; to comprehensively revise the Harford County Critical Area Program; and generally relating to the County's Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program.

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection A(2), Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program, of Section 169-1, Adoption; legal status, of Chapter 169, Master Plan, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for changes to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program; and to further provide that the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program, along with all maps and appendices as enacted by Bill 00-55, remains in all other respects unchanged; and generally related to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Management Program.
