The Criminal Law Article Review Committee notes, for the consideration of the General Assembly, that the prohibition against possessing machinery, plates, or any other contrivance to make a credit card without consent of an issuer in subsection (b)(2) of this subtitle appears to preclude a person from entering into or engaging in the legitimate business of manufacturing credit card making equipment without the prior approval of a credit card issuer.

8-209. RECEIVING PROPERTY BY STOLEN, COUNTERFEIT, OR MISREPRESENTED CREDIT CARD.

(A) PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT RECEIVE MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, OR ANYTHING OF VALUE IF THE PERSON KNOWS OR BELIEVES THAT THE MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, OR OTHER THING OF VALUE WAS OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF § 8–206 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) PENALTIES.

- (1) IF THE VALUE OF ALL MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, AND OTHER THINGS OF VALUE OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION EXCEEDS \$500, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 15 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- (2) IF THE VALUE OF ALL MONEY, GOODS, SERVICES, AND OTHER THINGS OF VALUE OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT EXCEED \$500, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.
