8-517. CIVIL PENALTY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS PART IS LIABLE TO THE STATE FOR A CIVIL PENALTY NOT MORE THAN THREE TIMES THE AMOUNT OF THE OVERPAYMENT.

(B) ADDITIONAL TO OTHER PENALTIES.

THE CIVIL PENALTY PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION IS IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED BY LAW.

(C) RESTITUTION NOT LIMITED.

THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT A VICTIM'S RIGHT TO RESTITUTION UNDER TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 6 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.

8-520. FUNDRAISING.

(A) "PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER" MEANS:

- (1) A POLICE OFFICER;
- (2) A PAID OR VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTER;
- (3) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN;
- (4) A RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER:
- (5) THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL; OR
- (6) A SWORN OFFICER OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.
