(G) SIGNAL.

"SIGNAL" MEANS THE ACTIVATION OF AN ALARM SYSTEM THAT REQUESTS A RESPONSE BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT OR A FIRE DEPARTMENT.

9-608. NONEMERGENCY ACTIVATION OF SIGNAL.

A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY ACTIVATE A SIGNAL FOR A NONEMERGENCY SITUATION.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.

9-609. MULTIPLE FALSE ALARMS.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY:

- (1) TO ALARM SYSTEMS ACTIVATED BY WEATHER CONDITIONS OR CAUSES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE ALARM USER;
- (2) IN FREDERICK COUNTY IF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREDERICK COUNTY ADOPTS REGULATIONS UNDER ARTICLE 25, § 211A OF THE CODE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF ALARM SYSTEM CONTRACTORS AND ALARM USERS, THE ISSUANCE OF CIVIL CITATIONS, AND PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF A REGULATION; OR
- (3) IN CALVERT COUNTY IF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALVERT COUNTY ADOPTS REGULATIONS UNDER ARTICLE 25, § 236D OF THE CODE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF ALARM SYSTEM CONTRACTORS AND ALARM USERS, THE ISSUANCE OF CIVIL CITATIONS, AND PENALTIES FOR A VIOLATION OF A REGULATION.
