9-704. IDENTIFICATION BADGES AND IDENTIFICATION CARDS — CERTAIN FACILITIES.

(A) APPLICATION OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON POSSESSING AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD REQUIRED FOR EMPLOYMENT OR VISITATION THAT IS ISSUED BY:

(1) A UNIT OF THE STATE OR A COUNTY, MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC CORPORATION OF THE STATE; OR

(2) A PERSON THAT OWNS OR OPERATES IN THE STATE:

(I) A FACTORY OR WAREHOUSE OR A MANUFACTURING, PRINTING, PUBLISHING, MECHANICAL, OR MERCANTILE ESTABLISHMENT OR A PLANT OF ANY KIND;

(II) A MINE OR QUARRY;

(III) A RAILWAY; OR

(IV) A WATER, SEWAGE, GAS, ELECTRIC, TRANSMISSION, HEATING, REFRIGERATING, TELEPHONE, OR OTHER PUBLICLY OWNED OR PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY.

(B) SURRENDER REQUIRED AT END OF EMPLOYMENT OR VISIT.

A PERSON SHALL SURRENDER EACH IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD TO ITS ISSUER WHEN THE PERSON'S EMPLOYMENT OR AUTHORIZED VISIT ENDS.

(C) PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY POSSESS AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD AFTER THE PERSON'S EMPLOYMENT OR AUTHORIZED VISIT ENDS.

(D) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO WILLFULLY VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.
