9-705. SAME — REQUIRED SURRENDER.

A PERSON WHO FINDS OR GAINS POSSESSION OF AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD REQUIRED UNDER § 9-704 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL SURRENDER IMMEDIATELY THE IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD TO THE NEAREST POLICE STATION.

9-706. SAME — PROHIBITIONS.

(A) PROHIBITED.

TO ENTER A PLACE OR ESTABLISHMENT IN WHICH A PERSON IS REQUIRED TO HAVE AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER § 9-704 OF THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY:

- (1) MAKE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD; OR
- (2) ASSIST ANOTHER IN THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF AN IDENTIFICATION BADGE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.
