10-608. SAME — COCKFIGHT.

(A) PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT USE OR ALLOW THE USE OF A FOWL, COCK, OR OTHER BIRD TO FIGHT WITH ANOTHER ANIMAL.

(B) PENALTY.

- (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF THE FELONY OF AGGRAVATED CRUELTY TO ANIMALS AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.
- (2) AS A CONDITION OF SENTENCING, THE COURT MAY ORDER A DEFENDANT CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SECTION TO PARTICIPATE IN AND PAY FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING.

10-609. ARREST BY HUMANE SOCIETY OFFICER.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, IF AN OFFICER OF A HUMANE SOCIETY SEES A PERSON COMMITTING A MISDEMEANOR THAT INVOLVES CRUELTY TO AN ANIMAL, THE OFFICER SHALL ARREST AND BRING BEFORE THE DISTRICT COURT THE PERSON COMMITTING THE MISDEMEANOR.

(B) LOCAL ENFORCEMENT — BALTIMORE COUNTY.

IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, THE BALTIMORE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, DIVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL SHALL ENFORCE THIS SECTION.
