## (E) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500.

## (A) PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT INTENTIONALLY MUTILATE, DEFACE, DESTROY, BURN, TRAMPLE, OR USE A FLAG:

- (1) IN A MANNER INTENDED TO INCITE OR PRODUCE AN IMMINENT BREACH OF THE PEACE; AND
- (2) UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES LIKELY TO INCITE OR PRODUCE AN IMMINENT BREACH OF THE PEACE.
