12-202. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES TO ALL LOTTERIES, INCLUDING THOSE AUTHORIZED BY ANY OTHER STATE OR FOREIGN COUNTRY.

(B) EXCEPTION.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO THE STATE LOTTERY ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 371A and the first clause of § 367.

In subsection (a) of this section, the reference to "this subtitle" is substituted for the former reference to "[t]he preceding sections" to reflect the reorganization of material derived from former Art. 27, §§ 356 through 371A, which comprised the former "Lotteries" subheading of Article 27. Similarly, in subsection (b) of this section, the reference to this "subtitle" is substituted for the former reference to this "subheading" to the same effect.
