

(1) LIMIT OR RESTRICT THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY TO REGULATE, LICENSE, AND DESIGNATE THE TYPE OF AMUSEMENT OR GAMING DEVICES THAT MAY BE OPERATED IN THE COUNTY; OR

(2) AMEND OR APPLY TO THE LAWS PERTAINING TO RAFFLES IN THE COUNTY UNDER § 13-405 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 255(h)(1)(ii) and (2).

In subsection (b) of this section, the former phrase "[t]his subsection applies only in Anne Arundel County" is deleted in light of § 13-402(a) of this subtitle to the same effect.

In subsection (e) of this section, the former reference to "casino events" is deleted as obsolete. See Revisor's Note to § 13-404 of this subtitle.

13-404. CASINO EVENTS — PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT CONDUCT A CASINO EVENT IN THE COUNTY.

Former Art. 27, § 255(h)(3), which established the requirements for an eligible organization to operate a casino night in Anne Arundel County before October 1, 1997, is deleted as obsolete.

13-405. RAFFLES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

A BONA FIDE FRATERNAL, CIVIC, WAR VETERANS', OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, OR A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY MAY CONDUCT A RAFFLE IN THE COUNTY FOR THE BENEFIT OF CHARITY IF:

(1) THE RAFFLE IS CONDUCTED TO FURTHER THE PURPOSES OF THE ORGANIZATION; AND

(2) NO INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS FINANCIALLY BENEFITS FROM THE HOLDING OF THE RAFFLE OR RECEIVES ANY OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE RAFFLE FOR PERSONAL USE.

(B) AWARD OF PRIZES.

PRIZES MAY BE AWARDED BY THE USE OF PADDLE WHEELS, WHEELS OF FORTUNE, OR CHANCE BOOKS.
