In subsection (c)(4)(i) of this section, the reference to "intend[ing]" to raise money is substituted for the former reference to "desiring" to raise money for consistency within this title.

Also in subsection (c)(4)(i) of this section, the former reference to a purpose that is "specifically" described in an application is deleted as surplusage.

In subsection (d)(2) of this section, the reference to a "gaming" professional is added for clarity.

In subsection (d)(3) of this section, the former reference to a "commission, salary ... or recompense" is deleted in light of the comprehensive reference to a "compensation or reward".

Also in subsection (d)(3) of this section, the former reference to "operat[ing]" bingo is deleted as included in the reference to "conducting" bingo.

13-1204. PROHIBITIONS.

(A) SUNDAY GAMING.

A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT AUTHORIZE A GAME OR CARNIVAL ON A SUNDAY.

(B) MINORS.

AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY, CONDUCT, OR OPERATE BINGO.
