- (3) THE OPERATOR OF A PUNCHBOARD SHALL DISPLAY WITHIN THE ESTABLISHMENT A GAMING PERMIT ISSUED TO THE BENEFICIARY OF THE PUNCHBOARD UNDER § 13–1304 OF THIS SUBTITLE
 - (B) QUALIFIED BENEFICIARIES.
- (1) A PERSON MAY OPERATE A TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD IN THE COUNTY ONLY FOR THE BENEFIT OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS LOCATED IN THE COUNTY:
 - (I) A BONA FIDE:
 - 1. RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION;
 - 2. FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION:
 - 3. CIVIC ORGANIZATION:
 - 4. WAR VETERANS' ORGANIZATION:
 - HOSPITAL:
 - 6. AMATEUR ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION;
 - 7. PATRIOTIC ORGANIZATION:
 - 8. CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION; OR
 - 9. EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION:
 - (II) A FREDERICK COUNTY VOLUNTEER:
 - 1. FIRE COMPANY:
 - 2. RESCUE COMPANY; OR
 - 3. AMBULANCE COMPANY; OR
 - (III) AN AUXILIARY OF A FREDERICK COUNTY VOLUNTEER:
 - 1. FIRE COMPANY;
 - 2. RESCUE COMPANY; OR
 - 3. AMBULANCE COMPANY.
- (2) THE BENEFICIARY OF A TIP JAR MAY NOT HOLD MORE THAN THREE PERMITS TO OPERATE TIP JARS OR PUNCHBOARDS OUTSIDE OF THE BENEFICIARY'S PREMISES.
 - (C) FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING.
- (1) THE BENEFICIARY OF A TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD MUST RECEIVE AT LEAST 70% OF THE GROSS PROCEEDS OF THE TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD AFTER PAYING WINNING PLAYERS AND REIMBURSING THE OPERATOR FOR OPERATING EXPENSES.
