

(3) THE OPERATOR OF A PUNCHBOARD SHALL DISPLAY WITHIN THE ESTABLISHMENT A GAMING PERMIT ISSUED TO THE BENEFICIARY OF THE PUNCHBOARD UNDER § 13-1304 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) QUALIFIED BENEFICIARIES.

(1) A PERSON MAY OPERATE A TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD IN THE COUNTY ONLY FOR THE BENEFIT OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS LOCATED IN THE COUNTY:

(I) A BONA FIDE:

1. RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION;
2. FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION;
3. CIVIC ORGANIZATION;
4. WAR VETERANS' ORGANIZATION;
5. HOSPITAL;
6. AMATEUR ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION;
7. PATRIOTIC ORGANIZATION;
8. CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION; OR
9. EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION;

(II) A FREDERICK COUNTY VOLUNTEER:

1. FIRE COMPANY;
2. RESCUE COMPANY; OR
3. AMBULANCE COMPANY; OR

(III) AN AUXILIARY OF A FREDERICK COUNTY VOLUNTEER:

1. FIRE COMPANY;
2. RESCUE COMPANY; OR
3. AMBULANCE COMPANY.

(2) THE BENEFICIARY OF A TIP JAR MAY NOT HOLD MORE THAN THREE PERMITS TO OPERATE TIP JARS OR PUNCHBOARDS OUTSIDE OF THE BENEFICIARY'S PREMISES.

(C) FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING.

(1) THE BENEFICIARY OF A TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD MUST RECEIVE AT LEAST 70% OF THE GROSS PROCEEDS OF THE TIP JAR OR PUNCHBOARD AFTER PAYING WINNING PLAYERS AND REIMBURSING THE OPERATOR FOR OPERATING EXPENSES.
